

**“TRICK OR TREAT” GRAB BAG AWARDS MEET**

**Sanction:** This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc., as a timed final meet on behalf of USA Swimming, Sanction Number MI091001. Michigan swimming rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as fully set forth in these meet rules.

**Facilities:** EISENHOWER is a 6 lane pool with a shallow end which will be available for supervised warm-up and warm down. Depth at start is 11.5ft and 3.5ft at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers are in place. Colorado timing with a 6-lane display will be used. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). The 25 yd. events will be swum from the starting blocks. Coolers are not permitted on deck or in the bleacher area. NO glass on pool deck or anywhere in building. Athletes must wear shoes when off deck. USSC is not responsible for lost or stolen property.

**Eligibility:** THE “TRICK OR TREAT” GRAB BAG AWARDS MEET is for all swimmers. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States of America Swimming (USA). A swimmer's age on Oct. 23, 2009 will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group.

**Meet Format:** All events are timed finals.

**Entry Limits:** Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis by date of email for electronic entries and date of receipt by the entry chair for hard copy entries until the Michigan Swimming four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned even if received before the entry deadline. To balance sessions to meet the four (4) hour per session time limit, the Meet Referee and Meet Director reserve the right to apply any or all of the following: (i) split age groups, or (ii) split teams. If the Meet Referee or Meet Director desires to either split age groups and/or split teams, the contact person of each club entering the meet and each unattached swimmer shall be provided with electronic notification of such change. Any club that withdraws entries based on such change shall receive a refund of such entry fees.

**Individual Entry Limits:** Swimmers may enter a maximum of four (4) events per day.

**Electronic Entries:** \$4.00 per individual event. Please include \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered.

**Paper Entries:** MS rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. Add \$1.00 per swim for all non-Hy-Tek compatible entries. Thus paper entries are \$5.00 per individual event. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge for each swimmer also applies to paper entries. Paper entries may be submitted to the entry chair on a spreadsheet of your choice however the paper entry must be logically formatted and must contain all pertinent information to allow the entry chair to easily enter the swimmer(s) in the correct events with correct seed times.

**Entry Procedures:** Entries may be submitted to the entry chairperson as of noon Saturday, September 26, 2009. The entry chairperson must receive all entries no later than noon October 16, 2009. Entries must include correct swimmer name as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. You can import the order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website ([www.uss-michigan.com](http://www.uss-michigan.com)). All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail to the entry chairperson at [cekingsley@wowway.com](mailto:cekingsley@wowway.com). **Entries submitted, whether by standard mail or by email, will be processed provisionally until such time as the entry chairperson has received, (a) the Team Manager Meet Entries Report (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your club's signed certification of entered athletes and (d) a check for the full entry fee.** The Complete "TRICK OR TREAT" GRAB BAG AWARDS MEET entry packet with entry forms is available on the Michigan Swimming Website at [www.uss-michigan.com](http://www.uss-michigan.com).

**Seed Time Updates:** Seed times may be updated by your club's entry chair and must be submitted to [cekingsley@wowway.com](mailto:cekingsley@wowway.com) by email in Hy-Tek format by October 16. Please include "Seed Time Update" in the subject area of your email. Any new entries should be sent in a separate email following the Entry Procedures guidelines.

**Refunds:** Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair, there are no refunds in full or in part.

**Check In:** Check In will be available 15 minutes prior to the start of warm-ups. **CHECK IN IS REQUIRED NO LATER THAN 45 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MEET.** Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from all events in that session. Also note that pursuant to MS Rules that failing to swim an event, after checking in for that event, will disqualify a swimmer from his or her next event. Check in sheets will be posted in the hallway outside of the pool.

**Scratch Rules:** Prior to check in close a swimmer may scratch events at the Clerk of Course. After check in closes you must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event. Once a swimmer has checked in for an event that swimmer must compete in that event or the swimmer will be scratched from his/her next event.

**Marshaling:** All events will be self-marshaled. Heat sheets will be posted in conspicuous places on deck and distributed to coaches as soon as possible. All swimmers will be expected to find their heat and lane independently. If a swimmer does not show up for the correct heat of the event, that swimmer will be scratched from his/her next scheduled event.

**Seeding:** The meet will be seeded following the close of check-in. All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest other than the 500 freestyle which will be seeded fastest to slowest, alternating genders in numerical order. The Meet Referee and Meet Director reserve the right to combine heats/genders in order to reduce the number of heats. Deck entries (if offered) may be placed in heats with open lanes.

**Deck Entries:** Deck entries may be accepted at the Clerk of Course and may swim if time and space permit at the sole discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet Director. Deck entries are \$7.00 for an individual event. Deck entries are subject to MS surcharge of \$1.00 per athlete if not already entered in the meet.

**Time Trials:** Time trials will not be offered.

**Admissions:** Friday admission is \$2.00 per person 12 & over.  
Saturday & Sunday admission is \$4.00 per person per day 12 & over.

**Meet Program:** Meet Program is \$6.00

**Scoring:** No individual or team scoring will be kept.

- Awards:** Each athlete will receive a participant award. Awards will be given to 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place in individual events for A, B, and C levels. In keeping with the Halloween spirit, swimmers receiving an award will be asked to pull their award from a “grab bag.” **Awards will not be mailed.** Swimmers can pick up awards after results are posted for each event. Please don’t wait until the end of the meet.
- Results:** Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming website [www.uss-michigan.com](http://www.uss-michigan.com). Results will also be available on disk (HY-TEK Meet Manager) to coaches only. Coaches must provide a flash drive.
- Concessions:** Full concessions will be available. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms, or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.
- Lost and Found:** Articles may be turned in/picked up at Admissions. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained in the home of the Meet Director for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).
- Swimming Safety:** Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.
- Deck Personnel:** Only swimmers, registered coaches and meet officials/workers are allowed on the deck. Coaches and officials must display their registration cards at all times. Coaches must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. **NO PARENTS ON DECK EXCEPT IN CASES OF MEDICAL EMERGENCY.**
- Swimmers with Disabilities:** All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.
- General Info:** Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for Coaches’ review at the Clerk of Course. Information will also be covered at the Coaches’ Meeting.
- First Aid:** Supplies will be kept on the pool deck.
- Facility Items:**
- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Eisenhower High School.
  - (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
  - (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
  - (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the Clerk of Course.
